

DESCRIPTION OF SENIOR PROJECT 2012-2021

Senior Project: Give back to our school community and leave your legacy!

The first part of your senior project is to submit your project proposal this is usually submitted at end of your Junior year, when approved, your school counselor will add SP to your schedule. This for is due no later than fall of your Senior year. Your proposal explains what you plan to do. It includes the general details needed to complete your project. For example: What will I make, perform, or receive certification in? How many people will participate or benefit from my project?

LEARNING SKILLS: What will you teach yourself (self-directed learner). These are brand new skills that will be learned independently or with the assistance of your mentor or experiences.

PROJECT DOCUMENTATION: One of the most important aspects of your Senior Project is the documentation process. It is through your documentation in your Portfolio that your mentor is able to evaluate your project. If ever there is a place to be "thorough", it is in the documentation of your Senior Project (pictures, research, revisions, etc).

CONNECTIONS TO LHS MISSION STATEMENT:

The paper must relate to the project in some manner -- it is not merely a report on your project nor is it about your project.
